Congratulations on qualifying for the 2019 Australian Youth Dressage Championships.

EA Membership Renewal

EA Renewals are due 30 June.

Please note the draw is provisional until EA member entry checks are done on Monday 1 July. All riders, owners and horses must have membership/registration and performance cards current for 2019-20 **before** Monday 1 July when member checks will be done. **If you haven't renewed by this date you will be removed from the draw.**

Please be aware the event is run by a small committee of volunteers and due to the short timeframe between EA renewals and the start of the event we do not have the resources to chase up individuals, nor verify last minute renewals.

Draw

After entry checks are completed on Monday 1 July an updated draw will be posted on the Dressage NSW.

Horse Registration Papers

You may be asked to produce horse registration papers at any time, so please remember to bring them to the event. If you are selected for swabbing your horse's registration papers will be required.

Arrival

Please plan to arrive between 7.00am and 6.00pm. For arrivals outside these times please contact Mandy Jones 0415 224 977 Please unload in the unloading bay and present to the event office to have your stable unlocked.

Medication Control

Swabbing will occur at the event. If you are selected by the swabbing steward you must obey their directions. You will need to provide your EA registration papers to the steward. Riders under 18 must be accompanied by an adult with authority to sign documents on behalf of the rider.

Catering

A food van will operate on Friday, Saturday and Sunday only. The riders retreat will be open from arrival. The riders retreat has excellent cooking facilities, including microwave, but you will need to bring your own cookware/crockery/utensils.

Rules Reminder:

Riders are reminded of the Equestrian Australian Dressage Rule 10.3 that during the four days preceding the first day of competition of the event, as well as for the duration of the whole event, horses entered in the Championship may only be ridden and schooled by the rider competing on that horse.

Callers are not permitted

A Gear Check is compulsory. Failure to Gear Check will incur elimination

Under rule 5.6 whips are not permitted in FEI level comps in Australian or State Championships.

The penalty for carrying a whip around the arena is 2 points per judge

The penalty for carrying a whip into the arena is 2 points per judge

The penalty for carrying a whip for more than three movements is elimination.

Horse identification numbers must be displayed at all times when the horse is out of the stable, including walking, grazing, under saddle at any time.
