## Conditions of entry

### Entries

- Entries for all events close on Friday 31 October 2014.
- Late entries and class changes will incur a \$5 surcharge which will be strictly adhered to. Late entries will be added to bottom of the draw.
- No entries will be accepted unless accompanied by the correct entry fee, camping/stabling fee and EFA numbers.
- No telephone entries accepted.
- Refund of entries will be given for scratchings made before 8:00am Friday 7 November 2014. Thereafter a veterinary certificate must be produced to claim refund.
- Number of entries per class will be limited.

### Rules

- The FEI Rules for Jumping and EA Addendum to the Rules will apply.
- All horses in Ring 1 must be currently registered and hold current performance cards with the EA.
- All riders must be members of the ACT Showjumping Club or EA.
- Australian helmet standards will apply. All riders must wear approved boots and helmet whilst mounted, including presentations, training, before and after the event.
- All dogs must be on leads and secured at all times. No dogs are allowed onto the competition arena or practice arenas at any time.
- All riders competing at this event will be expected to have read these rules and conditions and accept and acknowledge the waiver forms signed with the EA.
- **NO ABUSE OF OFFICIALS OR VOLUNTEERS WILL BE TOLERATED.** Failure to follow instruction from the Organising Committee members will result in disqualification from the event.

## Junior, young rider and amateur

- **Young Rider definition:** From the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 16 until the end of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 21.
- **Junior Rider definition:** From the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 12 years until the end of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 18 years.
- **Amateur Rider definition:** A rider 21 years or over who has never competed in an Olympic Games or WEG, not competed in Part 1 or Part 2 at Sydney, Brisbane, Melbourne or Adelaide Royal shows in the past two years or in a World Cup qualifier in the past ten years. Amateur Riders cannot enter a class that is higher than the designated Amateur Class at the Show. Excluded are horses that have competed in classes higher than the designated Amateur class.
- **Young Rider Champion:** Horseland Canberra is providing a Collegiate Saddle (RRP \$1,599) for a point score covering Classes 4 and 12 of the Program. Both Classes are restricted to Young Riders.

- The point score is 5 points for a win in each of the classes going down to 1 point for fifth. In the event of equal points the overall winner will be drawn from the hat by the ACTSJC President. Other participants in the draw will receive \$200 each.
- **NSW Amateur of the Year 2014 Series:** Class 10 is part of the series. Please visit [www.jumpingsw.equestrian.org.au](http://www.jumpingsw.equestrian.org.au) to view the rules.

## Draw

- All classes in each ring will be conducted in draw order. Preliminary draws will be available for viewing at the office on the day. Draw order must be followed, subject to next rule.
- Ring 1 is to take priority over Ring 2 and Ring 3.

## Presentations

- All prize presentations for Ring 1 and Ring 2 are to be conducted in the presentations area in front of the caravan. Recipients will be required to be mounted and appropriately attired to receive their prize.

## Camping

- Equestrian Park is being hired for the event and is available for camping from 7 November 2014 until 9 November 2014. Camping after that date is also available.
- The minimum camping fee is \$20 per horse carrying vehicle, which will cover up to three (3) nights.
- A fee of \$10 will be charged for each additional night camped.
- Camping fees must accompany entries.
- There are no showers or powered sites on the grounds.

## Equestrian Park horse levy

## Yards

- Open yards are available for the duration of the show.  
Yards – \$40 per horse
- Temporary fencing is allowed in areas allocated. This costs \$5 per horse.
- Yard fees must accompany entries.
- When booking yards, you should include what section you prefer – Section A, B or C. Temporary yards are in the Plots.

- The ACT Showjumping Club shall address and act upon all safety issues at the event. Due to insurance issues and in the interest of all equestrian events, including showjumping, your attention to safety and cooperation with ground staff is requested.

It is to be understood that under no circumstances shall the committee, its agents, or employees be liable for any loss, damages, claims or costs occasioned or suffered by any exhibitor, competitor or member directly, howsoever arising, including without limitation, losses, damages, claims or costs as a result of any negligence and by attending the venue and entering any class you agree to indemnify and save harmless to the committee, the venue owner, lessees, their agents and employees from and against any liability about of any such loss, damages, claims or cost.
