

What does Dressage NSW do?

- Runs major competitions and State Championships
- Manages judge and officials education and exams (although final accreditation is through EA)
- Provides support to clubs in NSW (advice, information, funding when available, medallions for club championships, etc)
- Provides feedback on and input into rule changes to ADC
- Manages squads programs (senior HP and young rider)
- Provides annual awards and performance medals for members
- Maintains the annual dressage competition calendar
