

# DNSW Clarendon Covid-19 Safety Plan for DNSW Competitors, Judges, Volunteers and Others



## **Basics**

- Adhere to the current NSW Government COVID-19 laws and guidelines
- If you are unwell DO NOT ATTEND
- Take note of information as to physical distancing, cleaning, where to get tested
- Conditions of entry will be available on website and facebook
- No catering will be provided by DNSW. There may be a coffee/food van on site. Check with DNSW or bring your own food and drink.
- STRICTLY only one person to accompany a rider (child/ groom/ owner/ friend etc) and NO SPECTATORS
- Children of any age count as "1 other"
- Riders/ judges/ stewards/ volunteers/ designated others are to advise DNSW if they become unwell after attending the event.

## **Physical Distancing**

- Currently need to obey 4 square meter per person of space to a maximum of 500 people (excluding staff)
- Keep 1.5m apart
- No spectators
- Stables and camping only available on request to the event secretary
- Riders arrive, ride and leave. No socialising

## **Hygiene and cleaning**

- Hand sanitiser should be available at the entry, outside the toilets and at the stewards station
- Extra cleaning of facilities such as bathrooms will be in place
- Face masks will be available for judges, volunteers, stewards and OCs if requested

## **Record keeping**

- Each competitor is to provide the numberplate of their vehicle as well as contact details for themselves and the one person allowed to accompany them.
- Competitors will be signed in and out at the gate
- Strictly no other person to accompany competitors (other than above)
- Officials and volunteers are also signed in and out
- A record of name and a mobile number and email address for everyone entering the ground will be kept for at least 28 days, including a Self-Declaration Form.
- These records will only be used for the purposes of tracing COVID-19 infections and will be stored confidentially and securely.
- Download the COVID-Safe app

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- Cooperate with NSW Health if contacted in relation to a positive case of COVID-19 and notify SafeWork on 13 10 50

## **Judges and Writers**

- Ideally judges bring their own scribes
- If scribes are to be provided, preferably one scribe for the day but at least for the duration of the judge, ie only one scribe per judge
- Writers to write collectives and comments, sign off on behalf of the judge
- Facemasks are optional
- Tablets, stylus, pens, folders will be thoroughly wiped down during change over between writers
- Judges box entry doors, desk and chairs will be thoroughly wiped down between classes

## **Stewards**

- Stewards will remain 1.5m from riders and/or grooms and other persons
- Stewards are responsible maintaining flow of horses at the Gear Check area to prevent horses from lining up and crowding
- Gear Check may take place prior to, or after, a combination has competed
- Stewards should make a visual inspection of equipment only. Where a bit may appear incorrect, the horse and rider should be escorted back to their stable/tie up area for a closer inspection (photos should be taken). If incorrect gear is sighted this must be reported to the C judge. Any sighting of blood must follow current EA Dressage Rules. If a noseband looks too tight during the visual inspection the Steward must ask for it to be loosened
- Stewards will wear a new set (one per hand) of disposable gloves per horse. These must be put on and removed as per health & Covid-19 guidelines.
- Stewards will use hand sanitizer between each horse inspection
- Face masks are optional
- WARM-UP arenas (based on 20m x 60m) – riders to endeavour to limit to a maximum of six horses at any one time to allow social distancing
- Riders should endeavour to maintain three horse lengths from other competitors whilst using the warm-up
- The warm-up will be supervised by an Official (steward, OC member) at all times to ensure that horse numbers and social distancing are maintained
